Current Status of Infrastructure of School System (Wiring, Network, Hardware, etc.)

Wills Valley Elementary School has a 1000 megabit Local Area Network (LAN) installed. We have internet connectivity for our classrooms and administrative offices. A series of HP Procurve switches and few hubs connect our LAN together between the majority of our buildings. The network server at the school has a 3.2 Xeon processor with 2000 MB RAM and 135 gigabyte hard drive. Our Network has a fiber backbone with cat 5 wiring to the classrooms. All desktops run Windows and Microsoft Office. The school runs a variety of network applications: INOW, Plato, Accelerated Reader, STAR Reading, Star Early Literacy and MacAleer Accounting software. Wills Valley Elementary School currently has 3 traditional computer labs and 1 mobile computer lab. We have 21 century technology in every classroom. This includes an interactive white board, projector, sound system, remote slate and hand held student response system.

Current Status of Technology Integration and Training

Technology has impacted all grade levels at Wills Valley Elementary School. It is changing the ways the teachers teach and the way the students learn. Attendance and grade keeping using INOW software is required for all teachers. Lesson plans are entered in INOW software at our school. We are using remediation software called Plato. We have several math and science related software products. Accelerated Reader program and the Star program are being used. The Internet is being used at the school in the classrooms, labs, and library. We are using a cross-curriculum software called Compass for math. We are using a web based testing software called Global Scholar. There is continual training to help teachers and students to better incorporate and utilize the use of Internet and software. Using the 21st century technology that is in every classroom, the teachers are able to integrate technology into every lesson.
