## **FORT PAYNE HIGH SCHOOL**

- Student Procedures for Monday, April 6, 2020 through Thursday, May 21, 2020
- Students should use their device to log-in into (Google Classroom, Blackboard, and/or MathXL).
- Each teacher will post a daily lesson (including elective courses) using (Google Classroom, Blackboard, and/or MathXL).
- Accommodations will be made at the school-level for students who are having issues with their device or internet service.
- Students are expected to complete assignments for each class in their schedule daily.
- Teachers will log-in daily to communicate with students, check daily learning objectives, while adding new learning opportunities.
- Teachers will post at least 1-2 grades per week in iNow.
- Teachers will hold virtual office hours 9:00-12:00, Monday through Friday to be available to answer questions from students and parents. This can be done via email, Google Classroom, Blackboard, and/or MathXL.

#### **Special Education Services**

Students participating in any dual enrollment, dual credit or college course should
continue to compete their assignments according to the procedures established by that
institution. Students will be contacted by their dual enrollment instructor.

- Student participating in any ACCESS or Credit Recovery Course should continue to complete their assignments. Students may contact their school counselor for information concerning their progress.
- Course credits will be issued at the end-of-the semester.
- Currently, FPHS will not have any athletic events or practices.
- Students participating in any Advanced Placement class will receive the new procedures for testing.

#### **SENIORS**

- FPHS goal is to create a plan that allows our seniors to graduate in a timely manner.
- Per the guidelines shared by Governor Ivey and State Superintendent Mackey on March
   26<sup>th</sup> Prom and Senior Awards Night is canceled for 2020. We will credit student
   accounts and/or issue refunds for tickets purchased as soon as staff is available to do so.
- We will make a decision on Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> about scheduling **Class Night** and a **Graduation Ceremony for the Class of 2020**. We are hopeful that event restrictions will be lifted in the summer months. It is our hope you can all come together as a class and celebrate class night and graduation.
- Students and parents will be contacted by their school counselors or administration concerning their current academic standing.
- Students will be allowed to complete courses needed for graduation. Seniors who have not completed their Civics Test must do so immediately. A link has been sent to senior emails.
- FPHS is currently working with state and city officials to create a plan that allows our students to participate in some form of a graduation ceremony.
- Students should contact FPHS for transcripts, testing information, letters of recommendations and any other information for college entrance.
- School counselors will be available to communicate with parents and students to assist in the completion of FAFSA.
